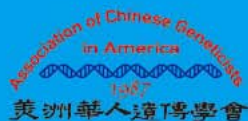

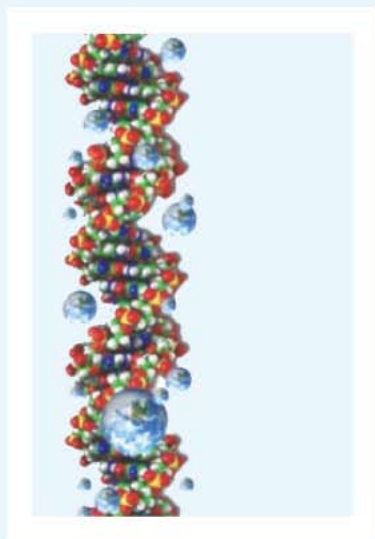

# Organizers

## Association of Chinese Geneticists in America

The Association of Chinese Geneticists in America (ACGA) was incorporated in Georgia, USA in 1987. It is a non-profit organization formed by a group of American geneticists of Chinese ethnicity but its membership is open to individuals of all races and ethnicity. One of the missions of the Association is to facilitate the interaction between the US genetics community and their colleagues in mainland China, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Singapore. The organization is supported by membership fees and donations. Included in its memberships are clinicians and researchers in the field of genetics including but not limited to molecular and biochemical genetics, plant and mammalian genetics, developmental biology, cytogenetics, clinical and medical genetics, genetic counseling etc. from academic, research, clinical and industrial organizations. The current membership is over 500. The organization is governed by an executive office headed by the President and under the supervision of a Board of Directors elected from active members. Its past presidents include Professor Yuet-Wai Kan (1989) (University of California, San Francisco, USA), Professor Savio LC Woo (1990) (Mount Sinai School of Medicine, NY, USA), Professor Lap-Chee Tsui (1991) (Hong Kong University), Professor Yuen-Tsong Chen (1996) (Academia Sinica, Taipei), Professor Ethylin Wang Jabs (1997) (Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, Baltimore), Professor Jin-Xiong She (2003) (Medical College of Georgia, Augusta, Georgia), Professor Li Jin (2006) (Fudan University, Shanghai), to just name a few. Election of officers and annual meeting are held every year during the annual meeting of the ASHG.

In the last few years, in addition to the annual meeting, ACGA had co-organized a number of international conferences with other organizations. These include the International Conference on Medical Genetics in 2004 co-organized with Peking University School of Basic Medical Science, Chinese Society of Medical Genetics, and Fudan University School of Life Sciences, the International Symposium of Genomic Medicine in 2005 co-organized with Fudan University, and the International Congress of Global Chinese Geneticists in 2006 co-organized with Peking University Center of Medical Genetics.

Hong Kong Society of Medical Genetics (HKSMG) was formed as a non-profit organization in 1986. The Society's aims are to promote the interest and knowledge in medical genetics in Hong Kong and to organize scientific and social meetings to facilitate interchange of ideas in medical genetics. # General Information

## Venue

Cheung Kung Hai Conference Centre, Li Ka Shing Faculty of Medicine, The University of Hong Kong, 21 Sassoon Road, Pokfulam, Hong Kong.

## Language

The official language of the Conference is English. There will be no provision of simultaneous translation.

## Geography & Population

Hong Kong lies on the southern shore of China. In total area, Hong Kong covers just under 1,100 sq km, consisting essentially of Hong Kong Island (78 sq km), Kowloon peninsula (12 sq km), the New Territories and 235 outlying islands (980 sq km). With a population of about 7 million, Hong Kong is one of the most densely populated areas in the world. Nearly 98% of the population are Chinese. The official languages of Hong Kong are Chinese and English. Cantonese is the most widely spoken Chinese dialect. Most vendors speak some English.

## Transportation

Hong Kong is easily accessible and served by direct passenger flights from all major cities around the world. The Hong Kong International Airport at Chek Lap Kok is only 45 minutes' distance from most major hotels and shopping areas. The Airport Express train can take passengers to the central business district in 30 minutes.

Getting around in Hong Kong:

Fleets of taxis, buses, ferries and trams, complemented by the Mass Transit Railway (MTR) subway system, enable visitors to explore Hong Kong safely and easily.

## Climate

Hong Kong is in the sub-tropical region. The weather in June is typically warm. On average, temperature is 27°C (80.6°F), rainfall is around 12 mm/day, and relative humidity is 82%.

## Currency

The currency of Hong Kong is the Hong Kong Dollar (HK\$). This is pegged to the US\$ at a rate of HK\$7.7-7.8 to US\$1.

# General Information

## Visas

British citizens or U.K. passport holders do not require visas. U.S. nationals only require visas for a visit exceeding one month. British Dependent Territories' Citizens, Commonwealth citizens and citizens from most Western European countries and Japan can stay in Hong Kong for up to three months without a visa. Visitors from certain Middle East and East European countries, as well as Taiwan, require visas. ## Voltage

The standard electric voltage is 220 Volts AC, 50 Hz.
